Idioter's Corner

I often describe it as the "miracle in Millbrae" any time that I check luggage and actually manage to receive it in one piece and in a timely fashion at the San Francisco International Airport.

Well, despite the usual problems, we had the "Miracle at the Masonic." No, not a spectacular finish in the Teams competition! I'm talking about Tania, Teddi, Dianne, the other directors, the caddies, and the food!

Tania and Dan have commented upon the snugness of the accommodations. They missed out on a huge marketing gimmick—**The FRENDLY SECTIONAL.**

Hacking it by Jeff Hack

Handling a **2♦** overcall over our **1^{NT}** opening (15-17).

This is one situation where playing natural fails and playing standard does poorly.

The 3 most common overcalls are

1) Shows the majors 2) Shows Diamonds and a major 3) Natural
Assume that it's natural. Is a double for penalties or takeout? If it's for penalties, what are the criteria? If you set the opponents doubled down 3 not vulnerable and you have a cold **3^{NT}** vulnerable you've got a bad board. It's not easy. If you want to do Stayman, the standard method is **3♦** with **3^{NT}** as the negative response but what if neither partner has a diamond stopper?

Some players play stolen bid (aka "shadow") doubles. In this system, a double is a transfer to hearts, **2♥** is a transfer to spades, and **2♠** has its systematic meaning. This system is a total failure if the opponents are playing Hamilton (aka Cappelletti) since the overcaller has the majors. Again, what is the meaning of a double of a Hamilton **2♦**? Shouldn't be for penalties since the opponents are heading for a major? Even Lebensohl, is difficult over the Hamilton **2♦** bid. I'll have more on this subject in the future.


