## Idioter's Corner

I've heard that everyone hates congress, but thinks that his own representative is doing just fine.

It is with that thought in mind that I wanted to say how I've enjoyed serving with both Lynn Yokel and Rekha Nirula who are retiring from the Board of Directors.

Similarly, it's amazing how when opponents ask you about your agreements, it's considered "grilling" and when you ask your opponents about their agreements, it's "just trying to get the information to which you are entitled". Well, it's only "grilling" when you don't know the answer. Sometimes "We haven't really discussed this" is the proper answer. But, when that isn't the proper answer, you should be a little more forthcoming. Particularly, you should be able to answer "forcing" or "not forcing" and if it is "natural" or "artificial" and, if natural whether it shows "length" or "perhaps just high cards."

## Hacking it by Jeff Hack

More on Counter Attacks to Interference of Your 1<sup>NT</sup> Opener

2♦ overcalls only

Assume that the opponents overcall 2♦

You have lost the ability to bid 2♣ Stayman.

You have lost the ability to bid 2♦ as a transfer to hearts.

The 3 most common 2♦ overcalls are

- 1) Shows the majors
- 2) Shows Diamonds and a major
- 3) Natural

If we assume that the 2♦ overcall is natural or shows diamonds and a major, we can usually ignore the major suit implications and assume that if we have one that they have the other. We might occasionally get a surprise, but this is usually correct. We might agree to play as follows:

A double is a transfer to hearts.

2♥ is a transfer to spades

2♠ is a transfer to clubs

2<sup>NT</sup> is invitational with a stopper in diamonds

3♦ is Stayman for the majors

3♣, 3♥, and 3♠ same as without interference

3<sup>NT</sup> is enough for a game with a diamond stopper

A delayed double by Responder is a PENALTY double.

If instead we assume that the 2♦ overcall shows both majors, we could agree to play as follows:

A double is a transfer to clubs.

2♥ is a transfer to diamonds

2♠ is Minor Suit Stayman

2<sup>NT</sup> is invitational with a stopper in both majors

3♣, 3♦ same as without interference

3♥ is enough for a game with a stopper in hearts but no stopper in spades

3♠ is enough for a game with a stopper in spades but no stopper in hearts

3<sup>NT</sup> is enough for a game with a stopper in both majors

A delayed double by responder is a PENALTY double


