Idioter's Corner by Mich Ravera

Although it seldom helps when I am on deadline, I often turn to music for inspiration. When that fails, I turn to my memories of a long out of print book entitled "The Official Rules". When even that fails, I am forced to come up with something original.

Here are a few of Bridge tips that I managed to come up with in the last couple of months. I'll give some supporting argument for them as there is room.

"Down one is declarer's fault. Down two is partner's fault."

In IMPs, bid games on 24 points AS IF you know what you are doing and bid games on 23 points, ONLY IF you know what you are doing.

"Black or 'no': Let it go!" It is manifestly impossible for opponents to have bid up to **2♣**, stopped there, and to know that it is right to be there. So, unless you have a good idea about where to play, are pretty sure that your side has half of the high cards, and are short of clubs, you are well advised not to help opponents find a better place to play. On the other hand, when opponents have stopped bidding at either **2♠** or **2NT**, you will have to go to the 3-level to get back into the auction and that might not work out so well for you.

As usual, I thank Wendy, Doug, and Ray for there contributions this month. I also thank Anne Boboricken for her submission that I wasn't able to transform quickly enough for publication.

Next Month's newsletter will be delayed a bit more than usual since all of the usual contributors to these pages and I will be at the North American Bridge Championships in Reno. I hope to see you there!
