Prez Sez by Ray Yuenger

The next unit game on Monday evening, September 13, will be a stratified pairs game honoring the unit members who became life masters in 2009. Come out to pay your respects and to challenge them at the bridge table.

The last unit game was a team game with an experimental format based on the soccer World Cup. We had 15 teams at the start of the evening, broken into three groups. The teams in each group played each other to determine a winner. The three winners and the fourth best team played a semifinals and a finals, while the other teams ended up in a Swiss competition. I was fortunate to end up on the winning team, with Panette Talia, Mindy Foos and Michael Fleisher. We played against Wendy & David Fotland, Peggy Sprague and Tim Prime. In the Swiss, the top B team was Miwako Wong, Roberta Murai, Steve Burnham, and Dan Turkus. The top C team was from a neighboring unit.

The unit board sometimes tries out new game formats. We had no idea so many players would turn out and, frankly, were unprepared. The food was calculated for the smaller turnouts we've had lately. Mich Ravera worked hard as director to improvise a movement that would accommodate everyone and then fit it into the scoring software. If you were there and annoyed by some standing around, I apologize. We didn't intend to experiment on such a large group. Our next team game will be in a standard format.

The All Western regional in Santa Clara is quickly approaching, running from Tuesday, August 31 through Monday, September 6. There are a couple of things to keep in mind. First, the San Jose Bridge Center and Oakwood will be closed during the regional. Idiot's Corner by Mich Ravera




Songwriters Brian Wilson and Mike Love wrote of the Endless Summer. Apparently neither of them had any experience in the northern California summer of 2010.

Summertime makes some people lazy and slow. I don't often use this space to write about grievances, but this endless summer has given rise to a few players who apparently think that Wilson and Love were writing about the "Endless Bridge Hand". The laws of Bridge provide two remedies for this. They are known as "No Play" and "Time Penalty".

Also, know that it is illegal needlessly to prolong play when you are certain of the results of all of the remaining tricks. So, when you get stuck on the board at trick 9 and can't get off, concede the last trick and let's get on to the next board (which might be even more difficult than this one).

27 hands at the ACBL prescribed rate of play of 7½ minutes per board should take a bit less than 3½ hours including a bathroom break and a chance to grab a few of the munchies.











If you want to review the board, remember that your review will be ever so much better informed WHEN YOU HAVE THE HAND RECORD IN FRONT OF YOU!
