Hacking It: Individual Games

When I first started playing Individual Games, you could play any convention and system allowed in a pairs game. I used to have a sign that said I'll play my partners card. Just in case, they had the same idea or no convention card I also had a basic convention card I carried. Once, I played a Flannery 2♦, Schenken 2♦ and a weak 2♦ on three consecutive hands. Then some wise person said that to be fair all players in an individual game must play the standard yellow card.

This rule has two problems: You have eliminated any advantage to players who are flexible and can play many conventions. If you happen to have a partner for a couple of hands that you play with regularly, you can't play your normal system and must play an inferior system.

A couple of months ago, I suggested an Individual Game at the SJBC on a Saturday Afternoon. Now is the time for action.

I am not a director but I am going to organize an individual game early in 2019 on a Saturday Afternoon. True to my word I'm going to allow any convention on the new open convention chart. The catch is that the players only have 30 seconds to decide on their system. Players won't be required to carry a convention card, but must alert and announce as required. The event will be stratified..

I will ask the board to make this a unit game. And then get a director. We need a minimum of 8 players but the goal is 32 players. The event works a lot better with a number of players divisible by 4. So to accommodate this we will have three players on call to fill in if needed. I plan on being one of the players on call.

More on this when we have definite information.

Idioter's Corner

When I substitute as a teacher in schools, I am sometimes compelled to offer the opinion "If I made the rules, they would be different." Sometimes I am asked to elaborate and explain that some things would be more restricted and some things would be more relaxed. I allow the more relaxed things when I can.

In a few weeks, the ACBL will implement some new convention charts. Some things will get more restrictive, mostly in limited masterpoint games. Some things will get less restrictive, mostly in longer team matches in the top brackets.

To my way of thinking, any opening or overcall convention that promises either an average hand (say 10+ HCP) or at least 4 cards in a known suit should be allowed in any game in which life masters are allowed to play. Once both sides have had a chance to bid it should be "gloves off". So, most responses should be allowed. The new Open Chart will mostly allow all responses. Some of the charts designed for limited games will have far more restrictions. The OpenPlus chart (which is designed for multi-session events without masterpoint restrictions and longer high bracket team matches) will allow some weak opening bids to be made without a known 4-card suit. We will see how it works.

I need to thank Jeff Hack for his article and for a wonderful game idea.
