Game of the Year by Mich Ravera

Sometimes the games of the year are flukes. But, if look at the list of 2011 top games, you will see Bruce Luttrell, Peggy Sprague, and Joe Chui with multiple top-level games and Ron Baron, Mindy Foos, Dan Turkus, and Miwako Wong repeating 2010 appearances or returning to the list from 2009.

Miwako Wong returns to the list at number one after having the top game in 2009, this time with Bruce Luttrell. That 77.68% game, narrowly edging out Kat Wesolowska and Joe, earned them "Game of the Year."

Jack and Missy Verson's fourth of July explosion of a game, third best of the year, easily earns them the best game by a married couple in the last several years.

Bruce and Peggy with a 4.00 IMP/Bd average, which on the standard conversion scale ranked a tie for ninth best overall, easily qualifies as the best International Match Point scored club game of 2011. To give those who don't regularly play IMP pairs an idea of how good of a game that is, imagine going to the partnership desk every few boards, picking up new teammates and winning a 24-board knockout by 96! Impressed? I though so!

Congratulations to all who made it to the list!

What's up with the Mid-Chart? by Mich Ravera

The Unit Board recently approved use of the ACBL MidChart conventions in all Unit games (that's starting with February) and in Open and A/X events in our Sectionals beginning with the Fall. The reason that MidChart won't be effective in the Spring Sectional is that the fact that we allow MidChart must appear in the advertising and it was thought that it was too late to change our Flyer.

This Unit's decision is unlikely to change what conventions directors allow in their club games, since most club games already permit MidChart methods. Some even allow conventions that are even more exotic than those permitted by the MidChart. But, a few are more restrictive. If you want to try playing any of the conventions that I discuss later or other MidChart Conventions in a club game, it is your responsibility to make sure that it is legal in the game in which you are playing and that you make proper disclosure.

The MidChart has a "gloves off" attitude towards responses to opening bids and defenses to opponents' **1NT** openers. Common uses of these permissions are a **1NT** defense known as "Suction" or to switch the meanings of **2♣** and **2♦** in the defense variously known as Cappelletti-Hamilton-Pottage and to exchange the meanings of **1♠** and forcing **1NT** responses to a **1♥** opening bid.

The MidChart also permits such useful opening conventions as "Transfer Preempts" and two-suited preemptive openers (in addition to the **2NT** opener showing both minors which is General Chart).

However, the most useful and unusual set of openers allowed by MidChart are those that have both strong and weak possibilities. One example is a **2♣** which might be either a nearly game forcing hand or a preempt in diamonds.

Have fun with the new conventions!

Idiotor's Corner

A song by the 1980's group "Dyvynyls" which charted in the 1990s included the lyric "If I forget myself, I want you to remind me!"

I was browsing previous January editions of this newsletter mostly just to remember who had good games in the previous two years but ran across a column that I wrote about people misguidedly using the Bridge table as a means of controlling things when they feel less in control of other things in their life. One of my partners told me that this was worth repeating, so I decided to do that with a slightly different theme.

As a director, I have heard all sorts of misconceptions as to the rules of the game, to the requirements for alerting opponents, and for conduct of the game at the table.

One rule of the game that everybody should know is that hasty call or play by opponents never takes away any rights you might have to replace an unintentional call, or to correct a revoke. Only your partner's play or call ever encumbers you in that way. In fact, you opponents' hasty play or call usually only legalizes an otherwise illegal (insufficient or out of turn) bid.

The World Bridge Federation has a very simple set of alerting rules. The ACBL's rules are slightly more complex because they have actually tried to make alerts somewhat meaningful. Would you want to have to alert Stayman?


Remember that the word "Standard" appears nowhere in the ACBL Alert procedures. Playing "Standard" doesn't exempt you from alerting or announcing your **1NT** opening range and slightly nonstandard bids don't always require an alert.

I, for instance, don't want to hear, and you are not required to alert, that your non-forcing **1NT** response to a **1♦** opener shows 7-10 HCP instead of whatever you think the "Standard" range is. If, on the other hand, your **1NT** response to a **1♦** opener is forcing to game (or nearly so), even if it shows a willingness to play in no trump, I really do want to hear about it! You must alert me.

If you play a convention and its name helps you remember what it means or you think that it will help your opponents, you aren't forbidden from using the name, but, the name of the convention alone is never a sufficient explanation and should never be offered or accepted as one. The reason that you shouldn't accept the name alone as an explanation is that your opponents may play "Scrambled 4-way Checkback" slightly differently from they way that you do. You should learn to say "Requests clarification of major suit holdings" or something like it.

Maybe by tradition, maybe by force of will, maybe by declaration of certain directors, there is a common misconception that North is "in charge" of the table. North has an obligation to make certain that his table plays the right boards and players who sit at the same table for the whole session are "primarily responsible" for getting the boards to the next table, but that doesn't give them any authority or ownership of the table.
